Students gather in the choir room, enjoy lunch together (students can choose to bring lunch from home or partake in a pizza lunch provided by the temple for a fee of \$65 for the year), and then learn music to be performed at Family Services on the first Friday of each month. Pickup for grades 3-6 is 12:30pm. The 7th – 12th Grade participants aid the younger students in learning the music, and then are invited to stay an additional fifteen minutes to learn harmonies and more challenging pieces of music, making pickup for those students 12:45pm.
