



## Composting Comes to the TBT Kitchen

As many of you know, the Garden at TBT maintains its own composting system and we have created a great deal of beautiful, nutritious soil from kitchen scraps.

As part of TBT's Climate Action Plan and Green Practices Policy, we encourage anyone preparing meals at TBT to participate.

Here's how:

1. When preparing food, save the extra leaves, ends and bits and pieces of veggies that didn't make it into your salads or vegetable and fruit plates.
2. We put up signs in the main and Sisterhood kitchens explaining what items we can use.
3. We have also provided a dedicated metal pail with a secure lid outside the kitchen door to put any kitchen scraps from our list.
4. On Sunday and Tuesday mornings, garden volunteers will bring the can to the garden to empty into the compost pile.

We hope that you will take advantage of this easy opportunity to give back to the environment.

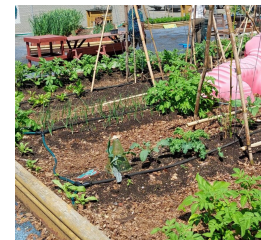
Robin Wexler did a magnificent job decorating the can and making clear that it is for compost only, no garbage. Stop by and take a look when you get a chance!
