Zionism: Not a Dirty Word

In the aftermath of the October 7 attacks, Zionism has been misunderstood, misrepresented, and attacked. In this course, we will seek to remind

ourselves of the origins of Zionism in Jewish thought and prayer beginning in the year 70 and until the 19th Century.

Then we will turn our attention to the early Zionist thinkers, learning who they were, what

inspired them, and how their influences spread. Together, we'll explore how today's Israel compares to the varied Zionists' visions. We will also examine how Zionism has been the target of attacks, beginning well before October 7,

and how Jews in America might best respond.
